# **Fadhb Gruaige**



Bíonn fadhb gruaige againn sa scoil go minic agus tá sé tábhachtach go ndéanann tú scrúdú ceart ar cheann gruaige do pháiste chun a chinntiú nach bhfuil fadhb gruaige aige/aici. Chun é seo a dhéanamh níos éasca do gach duine, agus go ndéantar gruaig gach páiste a scrúdú an lá céanna- beidh sé mar obair bhaile <u>an tseachtain seo chugainn</u> scrúdú ceart a dhéanamh ar chuid gruaige do pháiste. Má tharlaíonn sé go bhfuil fadhb gruaige ag do

pháiste (feictear uibheacha beaga bána nó feithid dhubh) caithfear gruaig do pháiste a ghlanadh láithreach, agus arís gach <u>3 lá ina dhiaidh</u> sin go mbeidh na huibheacha go léir imithe. Mar chleachtadh breise ba chor gruaig do pháiste a cheangail siar sa dóigh is nach scaipfear an fhadhb. *Unfortunately head lice is an on-going problem again this year. All parents are asked to check their child's hair thoroughly with a fine comb and treat if necessary. To facilitate a check of every pupil, there will be no written homework <u>next week!</u> The parents' homework, however, is to check your child's head carefully. Unless all parents take action at the same time the problem will continue to recur. If you find that your child is infected with either eggs (little white bits close to the scalp) or adult lice, treat your child's hair <u>immediately</u>. It is essential to treat again <u>3 days later</u> (after the eggs have hatched and before the newly hatched insect lays more eggs). Continue checking and treating every <u>3</u> days for as long as necessary. The lice do not like the smell of <u>tea tree oil</u>, so a couple of drops of the essential oil dabbed behind the ears and at the base of the skull each day are good preventative measures. <u>It is also vitally important to tie hair back, to minimise the possibility of the adult lice travelling!</u>* 

It is very important that you check your child's hair to ensure that they are not infected.

# Mion Eolaithe i Rang 5 Intel Mini - Scientists



Ghlac Rang 5 páirt i gcomórtas Intel Mini Scientist 2019. Bhí ar na páistí iad féin a eagrú i ngrúpaí agus ceist eolaíochta a fhiosrú. Ba dhúshlán é seo ach d'éirigh go han mhaith leo. Bhí béim leagtha ar scileanna eagrúcháin, scileanna fiosrúcháin, scileanna tástálacha agus scileanna measúnaithe. Rinneadar tionscnaimh ar phlainéidí, péisteanna, oigheann muiríneach, painéil gréine, solas i dteach lego, méarloirg, brathadóir aibíochta, Orbeez, an púdar níocháin is fearr agus balún aer the.

Tháinig moltóir as Intel le breathnú ar na tionscnaimh ar an Mháirt. Chaith sí uair go leith le na páistí ag éisteacht le cur i láthair 's acu. Ansin cheistigh sí iad mar gheall ar a gcuid bealaí oibre agus torthaí a gcuid tionscnaimh. Bhí ard mholadh aici don chur i láthair ar fad. Ar deireadh roghnaigh sí dhá thionscnaimh le cur ar aghaidh chuig an gcomórtas réigiúnach in Ollscoil Teicneolaíochta Bhaile Átha Cliath i mí na Nollag. An chéad cheann a roghnaigh sí ná 'Conas mar a oibríonn Orbeez?' le Donagh, Senan agus Senan. An dara ceann a roghnaigh sí ná 'Conas mar a oibríonn painéil gréine?' le Croíagh, Éabha agus Leah. Comhghairdeas mór leis an rang ar fad agus múinteoir Ailbhe as ucht an sár obair eolaíochta.

Rang 5 participated in the Intel Mini Scientist 2019. This project enabled the students to explore science through project based learning. The project was both challenging and interesting. Organisational, cooperative, investigative and evaluative skills were put to test. The students prepared projects on planets, earthworms, a compost oven, solar panels, light in a Lego house, fingerprints, a ripeness detector, Orbeez, the best washing powder and hot air balloons. An Intel judge came to view these projects on Tuesday. She spent an hour and a half listening to and questioning the students about their work. She was greatly impressed with the effort Rang 5 put into their presentations. She selected two projects to go on to regional finals in early December which take place at the Technological University Dublin. 'How do Orbeez work?' by Donagh, Senan and Senan and 'How do Solar Panels work?' by Croíagh, Éabha and Leah were the winning projects. Congratulations to all Rang 5 students and múinteoir Ailbhe for the excellent scientific work.
