## Pleananna don todhchaí Future Plans

I nGaelscoil na Ríthe déanaimid ár ndícheall timpeallacht foghlama sona sábháilte a chur ar fáil do gach dalta. Chun cabhrú linn an timpeallacht seo a threisiú, ba mhaith linn seomraí buan a thógáil in ionad na bhfoirgnimh réamhdhéanta atá againn. Cé go mbeidh airgead á fháil ón Roinn Oideachais, beidh tiomsú de **€80,000** le bailiú ag an scoil féin chun é seo a chur i gcrích.



As you know we have been given the go-ahead from The Department of Education & Skills to replace our existing cramped and very cold portacabins, which we use as learning support rooms, however the planners in Meath County Council have delayed our plans and the construction will not take place this summer as we had hoped. Not to be deterred, we are very much intent on replacing these with permanent rooms as well as constructing one additional classroom and a **multisensory room & garden** to the rear of the school. We see this delay as an opportunity to focus on our fundraising efforts, the latest of which, our **Golf Classic** is nearly upon us.
