

Eolas Tábhachtach Important Points to Remember

Do not send your child to school if

- has been diagnosed with Covid-19
- has been in close contact with a person who has been diagnosed with Covid-19
- has a suspected case of Covid-19 and the outcome of the test is pending.

Children are not permitted on the school grounds before 8.50am. This must be strictly adhered to in the coming year as it is vital that we ensure children are not mixing outside their class bubbles. Only parents/guardians dropping children to Naíonra na Ríthe and Naíonáin Bheaga are allowed in the school yard. Parents or guardians of children in Naíonáin Mhóra & Ranganna 1 - 6 should not enter the school grounds in the mornings.

Clearly label all your child belongings — it is more important than ever that all clothing be clearly labelled, as a "Lost and Found" box cannot be facilitated. Some coats have been left in school this week already! Remind your children that they cannot share their equipment with others.

This allergic reaction (anaphylactic shock) can occur through ingestion of peanut/nut products, cross contamination and breathing nuts in the air. Since this condition can be life threatening, we are asking for your help in minimising the risk to these children and maintaining the school as a nut free zone.
