Our Board of Management made a difficult decision this week and closed one class in the school for the entire week and three further classes today. We are confident that this was the correct decision as the health and welfare of the school community is priority. I would like to express my sincere thanks to the parents in question who took the correct precautions. As soon as their child developed symptoms they kept them home from school, got in touch with their GP and restricted their child's movements per public health advice. I would again like to thank the many parents/guardians who have kept us up to date regarding close contacts, testing and test results. Please continue to do so, as it enables us to be proactive in keeping pupils, staff and our community safe. Could we also remind parents/guardians of the following:

- **Do not send your child to school if they are unwell or exhibiting any symptoms of Covid 19.**
- **Children are not permitted on school grounds before 8.50a.m.**
- **Face masks are required on school grounds and also when waiting on footpath outside if possible.**
- **Please leave the school grounds/collection area as soon as possible upon dropping your child to or collecting your child from school.**
- **Entering the school building is by appointment only.** If you are collecting a child early, phone the office when you're on your way please, your child will be waiting to walk out to you when you arrive. The main door of the school is left open sometimes to aid ventilation in the building but you are asked not to come in please.


