COVID 19

Tá áthas orainn go bhfuil deireadh le roinnt de na srianta atá linn le beagnach dhá bhliain anuas agus go bhfuil rudaí ag dul ar ais chuig an gcaoi a mbíonn siad de ghnáth. É sin ráite, ní bheidh aon athrú ar na rialacha agus beartas cosanta i leith Covid ar scoil. De thoradh bhur síntiúis fhlaithiúil tá aonad glantóra aeir againn i ngach seomra ranga, chun cabhrú linn pobal na scoile a choimeád sábháilte.

We are delighted to see the easing of restrictions outside of school recently, however we have seen a considerable increase in positive case numbers in the school. Thanks to your extremely generous support we have been able to install and Air Filtration Unit in each classroom, special mention to *Moston Construction* and *Connon Stained Glass* for their support. These units will aid ventilation and in conjunction with existing infection prevention and control measures will help keep the school community safe.



CATHAIN LE FANACHT SA BHAILE ÓN SCOIL? WHEN TO STAY HOME FROM SCHOOL?

Níl féidir le do pháiste teacht ar scoil ar feadh 7 lá sna cásanna thíos: Your child cannot attend school in the following circumstances:

- Má tá COVID-19 ar do pháiste (PCR nó antigéin dearfach) If your child has COVID-19 (Positive PCR or antigen)
- Má tá COVID-19 ar aon duine eile sa theaghlach (páistí 0-12) If anyone else in the household has COVID-19 (children 0-12y)
- Má tá COVID-19 ar aon duine eile sa theaglach agus nach bhfuil an booster faighte agat (13+) If anyone else in the household has COVID-19 and your child is not boosted (13+years)
- Má tá aon chomharthaí COVID-19 ar do pháiste If your child has any symptoms of COVID-19.

Tabhair faoi deara, más rud é go mbeadh coladh thar oíche ag do pháiste le duine agus go bhfaigheann an duine sin toradh dearfach, d'aithneofaí do pháiste mar dhlúth-theagmhálaí theaghlaigh. Please note that having a sleepover with someone who has tested positive, will result in your child being classed as a household contact. Situation	Actions
Positive COVID-19 test (PCR or antigen test)	 All confirmed cases should self-isolate for 7 full days from date of onset of symptoms or if asymptomatic, from the date of a positive test result (either antigen test or PCR test). On receipt of a positive test result, no further testing is required. Any individual with a positive antigen test should regard it as confirmed COVID-19 and register it with the HSE. A confirmator PCR test is not required. Children aged 9-12 years old should wear a well fitted mask as much as is reasonably practical during the 10-day period. A medical grade mask (surgical mask) is preferable, if it fits the child well; otherwise a well-fitting cloth mask can be worn. Children can exit self-isolation after 7 full days and return to childcare and educational settings, once symptoms have substantially or fully resolved for the final 2 days (48 hours) of the self-isolation period. On exiting self-isolation after 7 full days, cases should be advised to follow health protective measures, specifically during day 8, day 9 and day 10: limit close contact with other people outside their household, especially in crowded, enclosed or poorly ventilated spaces (excluding childcare and educational settings) follow all public health protective measures.

Táimid ag bogadh ar aghaidh agus tá foireann á cheapadh chun an dearadh a chur i gcrích faoi láthair agus tá súil againn pleananna a bheith againn chun roinn libh sar i bhfad. sna seachtainí amach romhainn. Beidh infheistíocht de €2.5 milliún a dhéanamh ag an Roinn agus beidh foirgneamh buan a thógáil agus na seomraí réamhdhéanta ar chúl na scoile á bhaint. Coinneofar ar an eolas tú de réir mar a bheidh an obair ag dul ar aghaidh. We are currently appointing a Design Team to design and tender the project and hope to have them appointed in the coming weeks. Some of our old prefabricated rooms have been removed and a new state of the art room installed to house our ASD class while the construction takes place. We are delighted that we recently got approval to replace our windows and emergency doors. This work is under the Summer Works Scheme and will take place in July and August. We will keep you up to date with regular updates but as you understand, this project will take a considerable amount of time to complete.
