SCRUDAITHE Standardised Testing

For your information, standardised tests from Rang 1 to Rang 6 will take place in the month of May again this year. Please note that the tests will not be available afterwards for those who take holidays during this time. The main reasons for administering these standardised tests are to identify children who could benefit from additional support and to evaluate teaching and learning in the school. These tests are only a part of the ongoing evaluation done on both a formal and informal basis by your child's class teacher throughout the year. Therefore, it is not necessary to prepare children or have them study for these tests – it is always best when they feel no pressure, therefore giving us a realistic picture of their abilities.
